


Project Scope of Work

- Complete reconstruction of Penn Avenue within the project area
 - Street
 - Sidewalks and Bumpouts
 - Traffic Signals
 - Raised Intersection at Pacific
 - Lighting
 - Public Art



Project Area



Vehicular Detour/Traffic Control

- Westbound/Inbound traffic will remain on Penn Avenue
- Eastbound/Outbound Penn Avenue traffic will be detoured
- Local traffic outside the construction area will be maintained
 - Detour is intended for **through traffic**, keeping it off neighborhood streets to the maximum extent possible
- Temporary speed humps are being installed on Friendship Ave, Winebiddle St, S Graham St, and Roup Ave
- Access across Penn (North/South) will be maintained except for limited times during intersection construction.



Bus/Bike/Ped Traffic Control

- Coral/Comrie Neighborway will be maintained
 - Coral to be made one way between Latham and Aiken
- Planned EB/OB Bus detoured locally
- Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction
- POGOH station at ALDI will be temporarily removed during construction




Traffic – Examples

Construction Details

- Work Hours 7AM - 3PM
- Work Days Monday - Friday
- Staging – In the Children's Home lot
- Business/Residential Access – to be maintained



Construction Details

- Construction Inspector – City's eyes on the project, on site during working hours
- Construction Manager – liaison between PennDOT and the City, manages budgets, schedule, and invoices, on site as needed
- Will share contact info with BGC and FGC leadership
- Emergency contact 911
- Non-emergency: Jan Raether (jan.raether@pittsburghpa.gov)




Next Steps and Project Timeline

- Notice to Proceed Issued: January 5th
 - Allows the contractor to mobilize, mostly ordering materials
- Detour to be Installed: March 2026
- Demo Begins: March 2026
- Phase 1 (South half of the street) Complete: March 2027
- Phase 2 (North half of the street) Complete: March 2028
- Plantings/Closeout/Cleanup Complete: May 2028
